



ADDITIONAL SITE BRINGS EXPANDED BAG SIZE RANGE

Additional location, opening in 2018

We have made substantial improvements to our range of native plant stock and services. First, we secured an excellent second site last year on Takatu Rd (corner of Leigh Rd) close to our Matakana nursery, and we are steadily establishing ourselves there. Resource Consent to operate an “as of right” rural operation as a native tree nursery definitely hasn’t been a cake-walk, but we are making progress with all the required amenities and expect to be operating fully from there by mid-2018.

More stock, wider range of bags

The new site will enable us to effectively double our range, and to maintain our stock in the best manner possible. We’ll be able to hold additional stock which will be of immediate benefit to our clients because we can add 25L bags to all the main native species, as well as supply 80L size bags, thereby answering a need many of our clients have expressed.

Bags from 25 to 450 litres – a tree for every location

All our top selling species will be supplied in bags (with handles) of 25L, 45L, 80L and 160L. We’ll continue to stock some species in 300L and 450L bags. Our specialty, Pitt Is. Nikau range has also been extended to include 35L and 60L bags.

Overall the increase in our capacity to carry stock in an increased selection of sizes means you can get what you want when you need it. The wider choice of bag sizes is augmented by a broad variety of mature field-grown trees (4-6m) which we expertly dig out from our rich peat soil for delivery to you at short notice.

And of course (or we would have informed you), we have no Myrtle Rust, and continue to follow to the letter the recommended MPI precautionary measures.
