With last weekend's deluge the completed irrigation pond (some say Lake Matakana !!) at our new site is already full. Earthworks have ceased now until spring when the long establishment process will resume. Still to be finished are site levelling, roading, irrigation systems, and shelter.

### **Ewekuri (*Streblus banksii*)**

A gorgeous small-leafed tree with striking grey bark and willowy lateral or drooping foliage. Produces small yellow berries. (4m)



### **Coastal Maire (*Nestegis apetala*)**

A great hardy northern coastal tree, with attractive foliage and small red berries. New growth shows as a different colour. Like Pohutukawa, it's used to poor soil, drought, and wind. (5m)



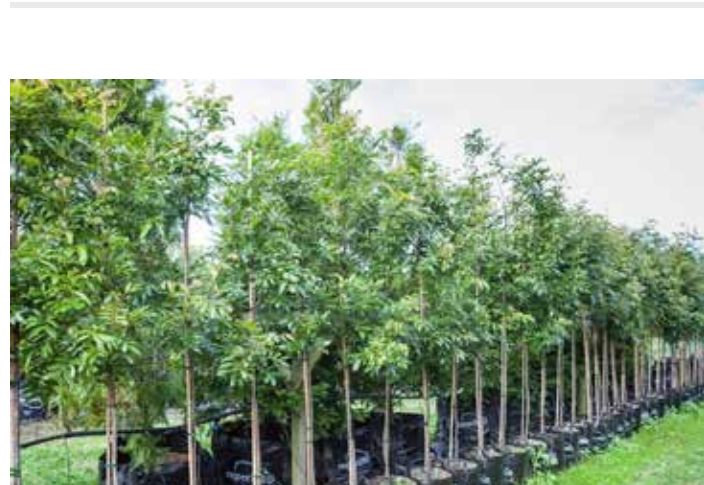
### **Baylisiana (*Pennantia Baylisiana*)**

Small spreading tree. Northern coastal, from Three Kings Is. Hardy, tolerates wind and dry spells, but not frost. Fantastic glossy, leathery, wavy, foliage and purple fruit. All stock comes from a sole tree discovery. Dioecious. Still rare.



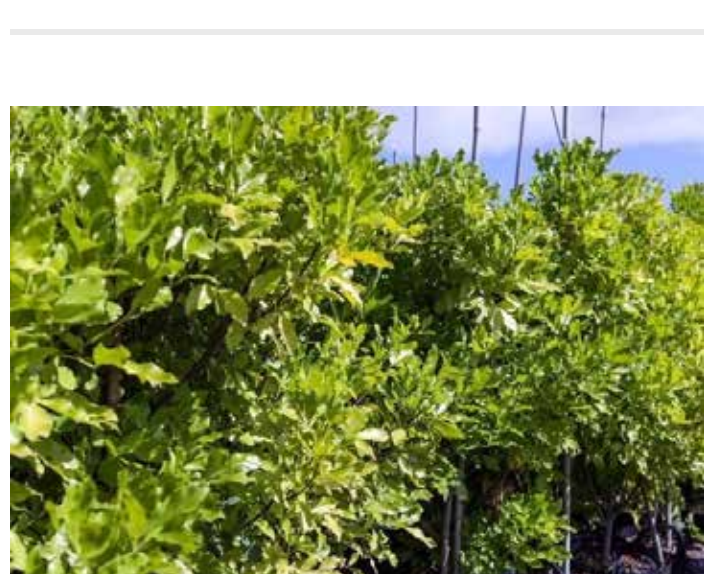
### **Tawapou (*Planchonella Costata*)**

Upright specimen tree. Hardy but prefers good soil. Northern coastal — found from Gisborne north. Shapely form, attractive leathery, shiny foliage. Spectacular large orange, then purple berries.



### **Titoki (*Alectryon excelsus*)**

An upright medium size tree popular in the North Island for its foliage, red berries, and full rounded form.



### **Wharangi (*Melicope Ternata*)**

Spreading specimen. Coastal and lowland suitable, naturally found from Nelson north. Hardy with attractive yellow-green foliage, black shiny seeds. Dioecious. A finer form of hedging than *Griselinia littoralis* (Papauma).
